AN ORDINANCE CANVASSING THE RETURNS AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON MAY 7, 2016, FOR THE ELECTION OF A THREE (3) COUNCIL MEMBERS TO TERMS EXPIRING MAY 2018.

WHEREAS, the Town Council called an ordered the General Election on January 25, 2016; and

The Town Secretary is hereby authorized and directed to make the appropriate entries of information appearing in the tabulation of precinct results shown in **Exhibit "A"** attached hereto in the election register maintained by the Town in accordance with provisions of Section 67.006 of the Election Code.

SECTION 4: CITY STAFF TO TAKE NECESSARY ACTIONS TO GIVE EFFECT. The Town Manager, Town Secretary, and Town Attorney are hereby authorized and instructed to take all actions necessary to give effect to this ordinance and the election, as provided by law.

SECTION 5: EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption.
