Man arrested in Southlake, Westlake, Fort Worth crime spree

An Alvarado man was arrested early Wednesday after an alleged crime spree in the Fort Worth area, according to the Keller Police Department.

Kenneth Sheets, 37, is accused of a home burglary in Southlake about 1:30 p.m. Tuesday before stealing a Trophy Club resident's vehicle at gunpoint outside Solana Club, 2902 Sam School Road, in Westlake, according to a news release. Hours later, Sheets allegedly stole another vehicle in west Fort Worth. He was arrested early Wednesday after trying to evade Johnson County Sheriff's deputies in a stolen vehicle and on foot.

"This is an excellent example of several jurisdictions working together to solve a case, and of the effectiveness of our regional 9-1-1 efforts," said Keller Public Safety Director Mark Hafner, who serves as police chief for Keller and Westlake, in a prepared statement. "Southlake, Keller, Fort Worth, Johnson County — we chased all the leads and used all of our resources for a successful conclusion."

Sheets was booked into the Johnson County Jail with bail set at more than \$90,000. His charges include Evading Arrest; two charges of Evading Arrest with a Vehicle; Theft of Property \$500-\$1,500; Theft of Property \$1,500-\$20,000; Burglary of a Habitation; Aggravated Robbery with a Deadly Weapon; and Fraudulent Use or Possession of Identifying Information, according to the release.
