## Construction work continues along Farm Road 1938

SOUTHLAKE – Get use to the detours in west Southlake.

As construction continues along Farm Road 1938 in Southlake, Texas Department of Transportation crews have installed temporary traffic signals, placed storm drainage box culverts and will begin milling existing pavement, according to TxDOT.

The completion date has been moved back to 2017.

The temporary traffic signals at Farm Roads 1938 and 1709 were being installed recently, and temporary detours have been placed on side streets, according to TxDOT.

Because of spring rain, "much of the initial work of the storm drainage placement" was delayed.

Meanwhile, more than six months of traffic headaches have ended at Farm Road 1709 and U.S. 377 in Keller where traffic has run more smoothly.

In Westlake, Sam School Road is still closed for reconstruction, and roundabout installation, at the intersection of Peytonville, Dove, and Sam School roads.
