It has been my pleasure to Chair the Time Capsule Committee celebrating our 50th Anniversary for the City of Westlake. The 50th Celebration Committee which comprises Mayor Scott Bradley, Town Manager Trent Petty, Director of Facilities & Recreation Troy Meyer, Junior Historian Advisor and teacher at Westlake Academy David Jenkins and Westlake Historical Preservation Society Director Jack Wiesman wanted the best and we believe we found the best with Tom Marak of Time Capsules, Inc. While searching the internet we found that Tom has made time capsules for over 650 institutions including Jamestown, Virginia's 400th birthday with President George and Laura Bush being present. Tom has also made capsules for the Clinton Presidential Library, the Flight 587 Memorial in New York City, Pepsi Cola, Alcoa, Microsoft, Eddie Bauer, Inc., National Gallery of Art, Museum of Modern Art, Henry Ford Museum and the United State Navy just to name a few. Quoting the Time Capsules, Inc. brochure, the inventor of the time capsule designed and installed much of the preservation and restoration equipment of the National Library of Congress.

Special thanks to the Westlake Academy Jr. Historians and especially Bailey Cochrum. Scrapbooks were made from PYP and MYP students. Their inclusion is one of the highlights of the entire project. The autographed sport shirt will be greatly remembered also by those who took part in sports at Westlake Academy. Hopefully you students will all be here in 50 years for the opening of the time capsule and look back on this great event as a wonderful time in your lives.

The idea with a Time Capsule is to capture what our lives are like at this time, a journaling dream come true and giving future generations insight—talk about a way to tell the story of the TOWN OF WESTLAKE, TEXAS -“The Little Town that Could” Time Capsules are a way that people in the future can find out about the past. We can't predict the future as we do not know what is going to happen to our culture, our technology, our knowledge so we can do our part to preserve a bit of who we are or that information might be lost forever. Think back 100 years-1906- when William Randolph Hearst founds the International News Service-to 1954 when the first nuclear submarine is launched, 1956 when the television remote control is invented or 1979 when the cellular phone is invented. 1989 brings us to the high definition television and in 2003 the Hubble Telescope detects the oldest known planet, formed billions of years earlier than astronomers thought possible. I got to thinking about our descendants and will they know what DVD-Digital Video Disc or CD-Compact Disc or VCR-Video Cassette Recorder means. Just think 50 years ago most food was made from scratch and today think of all the fast food as we know it. What will the next 50 years bring???

Please look through the exhibits of the time capsule and find the inventory sheet for a complete list of the contents. I trust that you will understand the significance of each item. Much of the material is on paper, probably strange to you since a paperless society seems assured in the next century. Note the letter from J. Glenn Turner proclaiming No Taxes for the Town of Westlake dated April 12, 1957. The personal letters from the Mayor, Town Manager and Head of the School will hopefully provide a flavor for life in our time and what the vision is for the next 50 years. Joyce Gibson Roach and E.I. Wiesman are completing a 50th Anniversary book called "The Little Town That Could" The outline is on display and will be included in the time capsule In 50 years, the people who open the capsule will find a variety of fascinating items about Westlake, Texas The growth will be of great interest since we were a town of several hundred in the mid 90's Figuring out what we might say to our descendants 50 or 500 years from now is one thing; actually writing it down and putting items in a time capsule is something else.

We could not have done this without the generous, generous donation of First American for their sponsorship that allowed us to buy this time capsule. A big thank you also to Medco for building the fine cabinet that will house the time capsule for the next 50 years and beyond.

I also want to thank every sponsor listed on the program for helping with this event.
