New installations will be tied to the Town's GPS control and location referenced to Right-of-Way and existing edge of pavement where applicable. **All construction work requires applicable "line locates" prior to any excavation.**

There is an inspection and review fee of \$200.00 for anyone other than a certified telecommunications provider.
